Thank you very much for The members of ReGIS which was founded April and in 10th July, 1996 the First GIS Forum @ Tokyo American Club was organized as a kick off of GIS Forum, inviting many GIS collaborator like Mr. Joi Itoh who helped me almost a year as technical OS Service manager and editor advisor to Junior Summit 44 top selected Junior students of 12~17 years old members from G7 plus countries Singapore/South African and 2 economies, Hong Cong, Taiwan. The most-busy 1 year but enjoyed attractive time.

Japan sent proposed from 8 companies CEOs OR chairmen to appeal at G7 meeting on 1995 March full 1-day joint session with G7 Industry Round table at G7 joint session day fixed to attend G7 amid of the week to negotiate to accept US developed internet Architecture to the world standard.

So, I talked to my boss, the Late Mr. Okawa, Chaiman of Sega Enterprise, he did it like Kabuki. Then got "Standing ovation" by the G7 board, including Later Prime Minister, at that time Minister of Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI), the late Mr. Ryutaro Hashimoto. Whom we briefed our plan to get his support. This changed the mood turned to redirect from Japan but they are the young stake holders soon, they need to experience. We need to have showed and tell in the worldwide. Let's computer industry give aways PC, network company, and communication lines and have them the voice each 3 minutes. I suggested to listen Customer voice from young generations of the world. Other than USA, at school, user of internet is not so penetrated so we need to let them use at least 6 months to practices kids, 12~17 year-old.

Now the late Mr. Isao Okawa became top execution executive, over execution committee, I proposed in Brussel, that in order to negate the EU's right of veto on USA developed GII (Global Information Infrastructure) and French, Spanish followed EU in 1994 in pre-negotiation session between Goa US VP and EU between. Then, right of veto was spelled.

Thus, Mr. Bill Clinton, the 42nd president of the United States stood up to call G7 top presidents or prime ministers, all to bring 44 industries round table CEOs from G7 countries of table industry CEO/Presidents to come up in Brussels and 3 days of discussions include one day with G7ministers. I was recommended by telecom and METI director general to attend as assisting the Japan team.







So, this totally changed my life to help open standards, not making money-based business consultant but as a visiting university professor to Chuo University graduate school from1997, 5 years as my volunteer base contribution; no fee base. On to teach "IT venture management. From 2003, once a week I was asked by and Kyoto university, lecturer 10 years and plus 6 years as environment governance board outside committee member, Shinshu management school graduate 10 years, Graduate School of Tokyo Denki University<TDU> 2 years. Using Kyoto University web-based lectures rial partner. Video lectures from Kyoto University on follow up, I spent all of my time implement junior summit a year.

Luckily, all ground table companies spent equal contribution and management help. Important fact, we need to realize and need the counter actions. According to Mr. Jacques Santer, Commission President on 1995, they did not want to accept GII (Global Information Infrastructure) issues on industry round-table team in the world 44 industries global top computer, content, communications, schools, game etc., headed by NTT chairman late Mr. Yamaguchi, my 10 years very trusted personal friend including I go play from my IBM and SEGA chairman CEO, the late Mr. Isao Okawa, my 12 years boss from 1984~1996 March end report published and sent over G7 all telecom executive sand united nation secretary general, the late Mr. Boutros Boutros-Ghali, he wrote me a very thoughtful message after congratulate junior summit end ever after I joined as assigned by G7 GIS Japan round junior summit as secretary general to plan and execute before march and report to G7 and, 1996.

The time has past 28 years, I think they did good work. Only 10% of them in the school at that time, not practicing online PC based debates and make a team report making cross the world. More than 100% as today, I still admire the use ware report of young people is still valid strategy as listen to customer voices.

One ashamed thing myself was, I feel brushed if I recall, we did not include any bad side of GIS using internet. If government or company executives should have been in much aggressive critical views oneself, if anything advanced so easy to use, or too carelessly think it is the great advantage for us we trust too easily, it would be used by very ill minded bad guy use purpose, they will beat us if we do not think we will be attacked always, chance to find the way out could happen and received round table summit report draft and refined by each team as we are doing today.

Concluded & sent out to all G7 pm& telecom & economy, G7 Brussel office GIS and un secretary general. And all G7 presidents and all-round table members by remote editions of 5 sub themes opinion papers and final reports draft was done 95% done by virtual net remote edit meeting session at 1995 before November and refining by GIS selected 44 people plus my executive adviser and operation management leader like Mr. Joi Ito and my CSK's staff reviews members announced at G7 Junior Summit.

In response to this, as I said before, the late Mr. Boutros Boutros-Ghali sent a message saying, 'Congratulations, Jack. The strength of the friendship forged by the young people chosen to participate in the Junior Summit over the past year has overcome any force that would destroy it. I hope that you will continue to have that strength.'




